THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 3-4 (1-2 at Tampa Bay and 2-2 at Kansas City), the Twins began their six-game homestand with a win over the Padres last night...tonight the Twins will play the two-game series finale with San Diego, before welcoming Toronto for four games from Thursday-Sunday...the Twins are 36-37 at home and 39-32 on the road...they are 9-6 in their last 15, 16-10 in their last 26 and 23-13 in their last 36.

TWINS CELEBRATE WILD NIGHT WITH POWER PLAY: The Twins beat the Padres last night by a score of 16-0, their second win this month by scoring 16-plus in a shutout (September 2 vs. KC, 17-0)...according to Elias, Twins are the second team in major league history to have two shutout wins by a margin of at least 16 runs twice in one calendar month; the Cardinals did it in June of 1944: 18-0 at Cincinnati and 16-0 at Pittsburgh...the offense set a Target Field record with seven home runs, one in each inning from innings 1-7...according to Elias, they became the first team in major league history to homer in each of the first seven innings of a game and the second team in MLB history to hit homers in seven consecutive innings in the same game...the Reds hit home runs in innings 2-8 at Philadelphia on September 4, 1999.

MEASURING THE METRICS - THEIR CASE FOR GOLD: Revised Zone Rating (RZR) measures the proportion of balls hit into a fielder's zone that he successfully converted into an out...RZR measures a player's range, taking three things into account: the amount of Balls In Zone a player receives, a player's total Plays Made, and a player's total amount of Out Of Zone Plays Made...it is, essentially, a simplified version of UZR and similar to Defensive Efficiency...for context: 0.940 = Excellent, 0.900 = Great, 0.860 = Above Average, 0.835 = Average...below are where Mauer, Dozier and Buxton rank in their respective positions in the AL:

'PEN PALS: Since August 1 - one day after trading closer Brandon Kintzler to the Nationals - the Twins bullpen has posted a 3.78 ERA (131.0 IP, 55 ER) in 38 games...in that same span, they rank in the top five in baseball in several categories:

IL PLAY: The Twins have gone 12-7 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-2 vs. Colorado, 2-1 at San Francisco, 0-3 at Los Angeles-NL, 2-1 at San Diego, 4-0 vs. Milwaukee and 3-0 vs. Arizona...12 wins are their most since going 12-6 in 2009...their all-time best single-season win totals in IL play: 16-2 in 2006, 14-4 in 2008, 12-6 in 2009 and 12-7 in 2017...they are 202-179 all-time in Interleague Play, ninth most wins in MLB since IL began in 1997...they are 90-102 all-time in road IL games and 112-77 at home.

- They have won nine straight IL games, their longest streak since June 17-27, 2008, when they won 10 straight...a win tonight and the Twins can join the Yankees as the only two teams to have two 10-game win-streaks in IL Play...Yankees won 13 straight from June 12, 2003-June 10, 2004 and 10 straight June 8-18, 2012.
- During the nine-game win-streak, the Twins are hitting .328 (103-for-314) with 23 home runs and 8.3 runs-per-game.
- Notables in IL games this season: Jorge Polanco is hitting .362 (17-for-47)...Byron Buxton is hitting .321 (17-for-53)...Eddie Rosario is hitting .323 (20-for-62) with five home runs and 13 RBI...Joe Mauer is hitting .305 (18-for-59) with 13 walks...Brian Dozier is hitting .296 (21-for-71) with six home runs, 17 RBI and 11 walks.
- The Twins are 14-5 all-time against the Padres, posting a .737 winning percentage, the highest vs. any NL opponent...they are 5-1 all-time against the Padres at Target Field, 6-1 at Petco Park, 2-1 at Qualcomm Stadium, and 1-2 at Metrodome.

BRING A BROOM: A win today would give the Twins their 10th sweep of an opponent this season (3 games vs. KC April 3-6, 2 games at KC April 28-30, 2 games at CWS May 9-11, 3 games at BAL May 22-24, 3 games at CLE June 23-25, 2 games vs. MIL August 7-8, 2 games at MIL August 9-10, 3 games vs. ARI August 18-20, and 3 games vs. CWS August 29-31)...the Twins have swept the Padres three times in seven series, their last coming in two games May 20-21, 2014 at Petco Park...the Twins had four sweeps last season...their last season with nine sweeps came in 2010; their last season with 10 sweeps was 2006.

WE'RE BRINGIN' SEXY BACK: The Twins will be celebrating Big Sexy Night on Friday night vs. the Blue Jays as Bartolo "Big Sexy" Colón will make the start...fans can purchase tickets through this special ticket package to secure a seat and an exclusive T-shirt...Colón was given the nickname "Big Sexy" from former New York Mets teammate Noah Syndergaard from 2014-16.

THIS AND THAT:

- The Twins have hit 65 home runs in their last 34 games, since August 8...since that date, they lead in baseball in homers, ahead of Cleveland (62) and Baltimore (62).
- Since August 17, Jorge Polanco (27) and Eduardo Escobar (25) rank first and second in the AL in RBI...Eddie Rosario is tied for sixth (21).
- Robbie Grossman is hitting .450 (9-for-20) with four walks and a .520 on-base percentage since coming off the disabled list (left thumb fracture).
- Trevor Hildenberger enters tonight with a 9.0 consecutive scoreless inning streak.

LAST TIME OUT: Santana allowed four runs on five hits in 5.0 innings with three strikeouts, earning his 15th win of the season in his last start on September 8 at Kansas City...surrendered a home run to Eric Hosmer in the top of the fourth inning...has pitched 5.0-plus innings for nine straight outings...threw just 67 pitches, his fewest of the season and the fewest in his career in a winning effort; fewest for a Twin while earning a win since Phil Hughes threw 66 on September 23, 2015 vs. Cleveland (5.0 IP).

AGAINST THE PADRES: Santana is 3-0, 1.77 ERA (35.2 IP, 7 ER) in five career starts vs. San Diego...allowed two runs on four hits in 9.0 innings, earning the win in his last start vs. the Padres on August 2 at San Diego...recorded his fifth complete game of the season...will be Santana's first start vs. San Diego at Target Field.

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: Tonight marks Santana's seventh start in Interleague play this season...is 3-1, 3.30 ERA (43.2 IP, 16 ER) with 36 strikeouts in his six previous starts vs. NL opponents...is 17-13, 3.80 ERA (286.2 IP, 121 ER) in 44 career starts in Interleague play.

ON THE LEADERBOARD: Santana currently ranks tied for first in all of baseball in shutouts (3) and complete games (5), tied for seventh in wins (15), ninth in hits per nine innings (7.48) and 10th in opponents average (.223).

ON A ROLL: Santana is 21-11, 3.05 ERA (303.2 IP, 103 ER) with opponents hitting .219 in his last 47 starts dating back to June 19, 2016...since that date, he ranks sixth in all of baseball in ERA (3.05) and 10th in opponent average (.249) among qualified pitchers in that span.

TWINS ARE COMPLETE: Santana has recorded five complete games this season...the highest mark in all of baseball...Santana marks the first pitcher on the Twins organization to have five complete games since Carl Pavano who had seven in 2010.

HE'S BEEN A HIT: Santana has allowed 156 hits this season...has thrown 6.0-plus innings and allowed four-or-fewer hits in 11 games this season, third most starts in the American League behind Luis Severino (12) and Chris Sale (16)...had just seven such starts last season and has surpassed his career-high for such games in a season (9 in 2012)...Santana pitched 6.0-plus innings and allowed four or fewer hits in each of his first six starts this season, matching Nolan Ryan (1971) for the longest streak to begin a season in history...was the second-longest overall streak in Twins history (10 straight by Johan Santana in 2004).

MODEL OF CONSISTENCY: Santana has pitched 6.0-plus innings and allowed one or fewer runs in 10 of his 28 starts this season, two behind Clayton Kershaw (12) for the most such starts in baseball...Santana had five such starts all of last season...10 such starts matches a career-high (2008 and 2013).

WINNING WAYS: His 15 wins this season already surpass his respective season totals from the 2016 and 2015 seasons (7 wins)...15 wins are his most since earning 14 earned wins in 2014 with Atlanta...Santana has won 10-plus games seven times in his career...began the season 5-0 (in decisions) for the second time in his career (started 6-0 with Los Angeles-AL in 2008)...is the first Twin to win 15 to start a season 5-0 since Carlos Silva started 5-0 in 2004 (Brian Duensing started 5-0 in 2009 after joining the rotation in August)...Santana's next win would make him the first Twin with 16 wins since Phil Hughes in 2016.
