**THE TWINS:** The Twins have gone 4-1 through five games on their seven-game homestand, going 2-1 against the Angels and 2-0 against the Orioles...today they will play the third of four vs. Baltimore leading up to the All-Star break...they will wrap up the "first half" tomorrow afternoon...the Twins are 20-26 at home and 25-15 on the road.

**DON'T CALL IT A COMEBACK:** The Twins beat the Orioles last night by a score of 9-6, scoring nine unanswered runs from the fourth inning and later...Felix Jorge was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing six runs on seven hits in 2.2 innings pitched...Trevor Hildenberger pitched 2.1 scoreless innings and earned his first major league win...the bullpen combined for 6.1 scoreless innings as Brandon Kintzler earned his 24th save with a scoreless ninth...the offense recorded 14 hits, three-a-piece from Kennys Vargas and Eddie Rosario.  
 ⚡ The Twins produced seven hits in 13 at-bats with runners in scoring position...that performance lifted the Twins season batting average with runners in scoring position to .254, the highest that it's been since the first week in May.

**ROSTER MOVE:** The have optioned right-handed pitcher Felix Jorge to Double-A Chattanooga...Jorge made two starts for the Twins going 1-0 with a 10.57 ERA (7.2 IP, 9 ER)...to replace Jorge on the 25-man roster, the Twins have recalled outfielder Zack Granite from Triple-A Rochester...Granite, who was recently named International League Player of the Month for June, is hitting .360 (85-for-236) with 14 doubles, four triples, three home runs, 24 RBI, 40 runs scored and 15 stolen bases in 59 games this season for Triple-A Rochester...the 24-year-old was named 2016 Sherry Robertson Award winner as Twins minor league Player of the Year after being named a Southern League All-Star and leading the League in stolen bases with 56...he was selected by the Twins in the 14th round of the 2013 First-Year Player Draft out of Seton Hall University.

**TWINS AND O'S:** The Twins have gone 5-0 against the Orioles this season...they have out-scored Baltimore 35-20 and out-hit them 59-42...the Twins have won six straight over Baltimore, dating back to July of 2016...the Twins last won seven straight against Orioles from September 1, 2014-August 23, 2015 (8 straight)...they are 14-5 in their last 19 against the O's, dating back to September of 2014.

**TWINS STARS:** Miguel Sanó (1st selection), Brandon Kintzler (1st selection) and Ervin Santana (2nd selection - 2008) will represent the Twins on the 2017 AL All-Star team.

⚡ Miguel Sanó leads all AL third basemen in RBI (61), second in walks (43), on-base percentage (.369) and OPS (.905), and third in slugging percentage (.536) and home runs (20)...Sanó leads the team in hits (81), runs (53), homers, RBI and walks...61 RBI are most for a Twin pre-ASG since Justin Morneau had 70 in 2009.

⚡ Ervin Santana currently ranks first in all of baseball in complete games (4) and shutouts (3), sixth in opponent average (.206), tied for fifth in wins (10) and ninth in WHIP (1.08)...his .206 opponent batting average is the second lowest for a Twin pre-All-Star break since 2000 (Liriano - .201 in 2006) and ninth lowest in club history.

⚡ Brandon Kintzler joins Doug Corbett (1981), Jeff Reardon (1988), Rick Aguilera (1991, '92, '93), Eddie Guardado (2002, '03), Joe Nathan (2004, '05, '08, '09) and Glen Perkins (2013, '14, '15) as Twins relievers to be named AL All-Star...he has 24 saves in 27 opportunities this season...the 24 saves lead the AL and trail Greg Holland (28) for second most in baseball...24 saves before the All-Star break places him sixth in Twins history (since 1961), trailing Glen Perkins (28 - 2015), Joe Nathan (27 - 2008), Rick Aguilera (26 - 1992), Eddie Guardado (26 - 2002) and Joe Nathan (25 - 2005).

**HOME IS NOW WHERE THE HEART IS:** The Twins have won six of their last eight at Target Field...in their last 15 home games, they are hitting .290 (149-for-513) with 23 doubles, 19 home runs, a .352 on-base percentage and 5.4 runs-per-game...in that same span, they are hitting .364 (48-for-132) with runners in scoring position at home.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 2015, All-Star Glen Perkins converted his 28th straight save opportunity, setting a club record, passing Joe Nathan's 27 straight (May 8-August 15, 2004)...it marked his 116th career save, tying Eddie Guardado for third on the Twins all-time list (Joe Nathan - 260, Rick Aguilera - 254).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Mejía earned the win in his last start on July 3 vs. Los Angeles-AL, allowing three runs on nine hits in 7.0 innings...allowed two runs in the fourth inning and a solo home run to Luis Valbuena in the seventh...was his third-straight win...matched a career-high with 7.0 innings pitched (also: May 21 vs. Kansas City) and nine hits allowed (also: June 12 vs. Seattle).

**AGAINST THE ORIOLES:** Mejía is making his first career start vs. Baltimore...has two career starts against the AL East, going 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA (10.2 IP, 2 ER).

**ON A ROLL AS OF LATE:** Mejía is 3-0 with a 1.53 ERA (17.2 IP, 3 ER) in his last three starts, holding opponents to a .232 average...just three of his 16 hits allowed in those three starts have gone for extra bases.

**COOL UNDER PRESSURE:** Mejía is holding opponents to a .176 average (19-for-108) with 30 strikeouts with runners on base and a .173 average (9-for-52) with 14 strikeouts with runners in scoring position...opponents are hitting .342 (40-for-117) vs. Mejía with nobody on base.

**ON THE ROOKIE LEADERBOARD:** Mejía ranks fourth among American League rookies in innings pitched (58.1) and tied for fourth in wins (4).

**OUT(S) OF ORDER:** Is holding opponent's No. 1-5 hitters to a collective .254 average (35-for-138)...No. 7-9 hitters, meanwhile, are hitting .301 (19-for-63), with seven of the 13 hits allowed going for extra bases.

**HOT AND COLD:** Has pitched 5.0-plus innings and allowed two or fewer runs in six of his 12 starts this season, posting a 1.87 ERA (33.2 IP, 7 ER) in those games...hasn't done so in this other six starts, posting a 7.33 ERA (27.0 IP, 22 ER)...has lasted fewer than 5.0 innings and allowed multiple runs in four of the latter starts.

**WELL TRAVELED:** Mejía began the season with Minnesota and made three starts, posting an 0-1 record with a 5.79 ERA (9.1 IP, 6 ER)...the Twins lost all three starts...was optioned to Triple-A Rochester on April 23...recalled to be the 26th man on the roster for a doubleheader with Kansas City on May 21 and started the second game, earning his first-career win after allowing three runs in 7.0 innings...returned to Rochester following the game but was recalled again on May 26 and started for Minnesota vs. Tampa Bay the following day...is making his ninth-straight start with Minnesota on his current stint with the club.

**FOR THE RED WINGS:** Mejía was 0-1, 3.48 ERA (20.2 IP, 8 ER) with three walks and 16 strikeouts in four starts for Triple-A Rochester after being sent down on April 23.

**STILL NEW TO TOWN:** Acquired from San Francisco in exchange for 2016 All-Star Eduardo Núñez on July 28, and reported to Triple-A Rochester...made three starts for the Red Wings, going 1-2, 4.66 ERA (19.1 IP, 10 ER) with three walks and 20 strikeouts before being recalled August 20...made major league debut August 20 at Kansas City, allowing two runs on five hits in 2.1 innings of relief...optioned back to Rochester following the game.

**THE FUTURE IS NOW:** Mejía participated in the 2016 MLB Futures Game at Petco Park for the World Team, pitching a scoreless ninth inning with a strikeout...ranked by *Baseball America* as Minnesota's No. 6 prospect entering the 2017 season.
