ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1974, Bert Blyleven pitched a one-hitter for the Twins against Texas, a Toby Harrah solo home run in the third inning being his only hit allowed...it was one of six career complete game one-hitters for Blyleven and one of three as a Twin... on this day in 1988, Twins radio ace Dan Gladden went 0-for-4 with three strikeouts against the Brewers, his career-high (19 times)...
