THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 1-2 through three games on their seven-game roadtrip, losing a three-game series at Tampa Bay this week...tonight the Twins begin a four-game series at Kauffman Stadium, their final trip to KC in 2017...the Twins are 35-37 at home and 37-30 on the road...they are 20-11 in their last 31.

TWINS PICK UP BIG WIN AND LEAVE FLORIDA: The Twins beat the Rays yesterday afternoon by a score of 10-6, avoiding the three-game sweep...Aaron Slegers made his second career start, allowing five runs on five hits in 4.0 innings pitched...the bullpen combined to allow one run in 5.0 innings...the offense recorded 10 hits, with five players recording multiple hits.

TWINS AND ROYALS: The Twins and Royals are playing the 16th of 19 games this season...they are 9-6 against the Royals this season, going 6-3 at Target Field and 3-3 at Kauffman Stadium...they lost their last series at Kauffman three games to one June 30-July 2...nine wins are their most vs. KC in a season since going 11-7 in 2012.

⊕ Eduardo Escobar has hit safely in eight straight at Kauffman Stadium, hitting .379 (11-for-29) with a .471 on-base percentage in that span.

⊕ Max Kepler has reached safely in 17 straight starts vs. KC... .434 OBP in that span.

⊕ Joe Mauer is hitting .317 (228-for-720) with 42 doubles, four triples, 14 home runs, 119 RBI and a .401 on-base percentage in 194 career games against the Royals...he leads all actives in batting average and on-base percentage vs. KC (minimum 500 at-bats).

GET YOUR ERASERS AND WHITE-OUT: Major League Baseball made a scoring change from Sunday afternoon's game with Kansas City...Eduardo Escobar has been credited with a double in the ninth inning, erasing an error from left fielder Alex Gordon.

MAUER MILESTONES: Joe Mauer needs one RBI to pass Justin Morneau and move into fifth on the Twins all-time RBI list and six runs scored to tie Rod Carew for third:

ABOVE AVERAGE JOE: Joe Mauer has reached safely via hit or walk in 15 straight, hitting .411 (23-for-56) with eight doubles, four walks and a .459 on-base percentage...in fact, in 26 games since August 10, he is hitting .416 (42-for-101), trailing Avisail Garcia (.417) for second best in baseball since that date.

TAKE THE ROAD BACK: The Twins are 14-21 on the road since June 26 after starting the season 23-9 away from Target Field...they enter play with the fifth best road winning percentage (.552) in baseball, trailing Houston (.682), Cleveland (.635), Washington (.625), and Los Angeles-NL (.588).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1970, Brant Aleya drives in all seven Twins runs on two homers in game 1, then drives in two more in the nitecap as the Twins sweep the Brewers, 7-6, and 8-3...Stan Williams (9-0) wins his ninth straight to set a Twins record...in Game 2, Hal Haydel makes his first major league appearance a good one, pitching 5.0 innings of relief to win, and also hitting his first big league home run.

LAST TIME OUT FOR TWINS: Gibson allowed five hits in 6.0 scoreless innings with five strikeouts, earning his ninth win of the season in his last start on September 2 vs. Kansas City...was his first outing this season without allowing any earned runs...has a record of 3-0, 1.37 ERA (19.2 IP, 3 ER) with just two walks and 20 strikeouts in his last three starts.

AGAINST THE ROYALS: Gibson is 6-4, 3.53 ERA (86.2 IP, 34 ER) in 14 career starts vs. the Royals...Gibson earned the win in his last start on September 2 vs. the Royals, allowing five hits in 6.0 scoreless innings with five strikeouts...is 2-2, 3.18 ERA (39.2 IP, 14 ER) in six career starts vs. the Royals at Kauffman Stadium...his 86.2 innings pitched are his personal most vs. any opponent.

THEY HAVE HIS BACK: The Twins are giving Gibson 7.0 runs of support per start, the highest mark in the American League among pitchers to make at least 23 starts...is the only pitcher in baseball this season to win multiple games in which he gave up six or more runs...Minnesota is 13-11 in Gibson's starts this season, including going 4-1 in his last five starts.

TROUBLE WITH THE LONG BALL: Gibson is allowing 1.33 home runs per 9.0 innings this season, up from his career average of 1.00...has allowed 19 homers in his 128.1 innings this season...seven of the 19 homers have come with runners on base...allowed a career-high 20 home runs in 147.1 innings last season...has allowed just three homers in his last eight starts (47.0 IP).

NOT SO LUCKY: Opponents are hitting .336 on balls in play vs. Gibson this season, and .363 on balls in play at Target Field...Gibson fell victim to a .332 opponents average on balls in play last season, the fifth-highest mark in the American League among pitchers to make at least 25 starts.

DOUBLING THEM UP: Has induced 15 groundball double plays in his last 17 starts (97.0 IP) after producing just four in his first seven starts (31.1 IP)...ranks tied for third in the American League in double plays since May 28 (15)...teammate Jose Berríos is also ranked ninth in that span...his 18 double plays lead the Twins...ranked tied for fifth in the American League with 21 double plays last season.

PITCHING IN PATTERNS: Gibson began the season with an 0-4 record before winning four straight decisions from May 22-June 13...his four-game winning streak matched a career-long (June 27-July 12, 2015)...posted a 5.46 ERA (28.0 IP, 17 ER) during the winning streak...is 5-6, 4.26 ERA (74.0 IP, 35 ER) in 13 starts since the winning streak came to an end.

MR. 100: Gibson made his 100th career start on April 12 at Detroit, all with Minnesota...is the first pitcher to make 100 starts for the Twins since Francisco Liriano from 2005-11...is the 25th pitcher in Twins history to make 100-plus starts for the club.

PUTTING THE "K" IN KYLE: Gibson has tallied 100-plus strikeouts in three straight seasons, becoming the first Twins starter to do so since Scott Baker from 2008-10...his 480 strikeouts since 2013 lead the club...he's racked up the most strikeouts by a Twin in his first four seasons since Kyle Lohse from 2001-04; he ranks 11th in club history for strikeouts in a player's first four seasons.

- Given 2015 Joseph W. Haynes Award for Twins Pitcher of the Year voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of the BBWAA.
- His 2.85 ERA pre-ASG in 2015 was the fourth lowest for a Twins starter since 1992 with a minimum of 80.0 IP (Liriano - 1.83 in 2006, Santana - 2.75 in 2007, Radke - 2.77 in 1998).
- In 2014, his first full season in the majors, became one of three pitchers in Twins history to win each of their first three games while posting a sub-1.00 ERA.
- Earned the win in his MLB debut 6/29/13 vs. KC allowing three runs on eight hits in 6.0 innings.
- Named the Twins Minor League Player of the Week, ending May 12, 2013 after tossing his CG SHO.
- Was named an Arizona Fall League Rising star in 2012 and the AFL Player of the Week, 10/23/12.
- Selected to the 2011 Futures Game where he tossed 1.1 inning, allowing two hits.
- Named to the 2010 Eastern League Mid-Season All-Star Team.
- Named the Florida State League Pitcher of the Week, May 3, 2010.
- Selected in the first round (22nd overall) by the Twins in the 2009 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Missouri as a senior...major was communications.
- Originally selected by Philadelphia in the 36th round of the 2006 First-Year Player Draft out of Greenfield Central High School in Greenfield, IN.
- Named to the All-Big 12 honorable mention team in 2007 and 2008 and All-Big 12 First-Team in 2009 as the Tigers' Friday night starter.
