**THE TWINS:** The Twins have gone 2-2 through four games on their seven-game roadtrip, losing two of three to Tampa Bay, followed by a win over the Royals last night...tonight the Twins will play the second of four at Kauffman Stadium, their final trip to KC in 2017...the Twins are 35-37 at home and 38-30 on the road...they are 21-11 in their last 32.

**BIG COMEBACK IN KAUFFMAN:** The Twins beat the Royals last night by a score of 4-2, scoring three runs in the top of the ninth inning, marking their third win this season when trailing after eight innings (3-59)...Kyle Gibson was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on eight hits in 7.0 innings pitched...Joe Mauer reached base five times (3 hits, 2 walks), the 17th time in his career to reach five-plus times...it marked the 33rd comeback win for the Twins this season.

**TWINS AND ROYALS:** The Twins and Royals are playing the 17th of 19 games this season...they are 10-6 against the Royals this season, going 6-3 at Target Field and 4-3 at Kauffman Stadium...last night's win secured the season-series for the first time over KC since going 11-7 in 2012.

⊕ Max Kepler has reached safely in 18 straight starts vs. KC... 438 OBP in that span.  
⊕ Joe Mauer is hitting .320 (231-for-723) with 43 doubles, four triples, 14 home runs, 119 RBI and a .405 on-base percentage in 195 career games against the Royals...he leads all actives in batting average and on-base percentage vs. KC (minimum 500 at-bats).

**MAUER MILESTONES:** Joe Mauer hit his 396th career double last night and is four away from becoming the second player in club history to reach 400 (Puckett - 414)...additionally, he needs one RBI to pass Justin Morneau and move into fifth on the Twins all-time RBI list and six runs scored to tie Rod Carew for third:

**ABOVE AVERAGE JOE:** Joe Mauer reached base five times in a game last night for the 17th time in his career...has reached safely via hit or walk in 16 straight, hitting .441 (26-for-59) with nine doubles, six walks and a .400 on-base percentage...in fact, in 27 games since August 10, he is hitting .433 (45-for-104), the best in baseball since that date...since that date only Joe Votto (61) and Charlie Blackmon (58) have been on base more than Mauer (55).

**A LOOK AT THE STANDINGS:** AL Central (left) and AL Wildcard (right) standings below...on September 8, 2016, the Twins were 52-88, in fifth place in the division and -29.5 games back.

**HIP HIP JORGE!:** Since August 1, Jorge Polanco is hitting .370 (47-for-127) with 13 doubles, two triples, seven home runs, 30 RBI, 20 runs scored, a .421 on-base percentage, .669 slugging percentage and a 1.091 OPS...MLB ranks since that date: third in average, tied for third in doubles, sixth in OPS, tied for sixth in RBI, tied for seventh in hits, and seventh in slugging.

**POWER PLAY:** The Twins have hit 53 home runs in their last 30 games, since August 8...since that date, they rank third in baseball in homers, trailing Cleveland (56) and Baltimore (55)...individually since that date, Brian Dozier is tied for seventh in the AL (9) and Byron Buxton and Eddie Rosario (8) are tied for 10th.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS AND ROYALS HISTORY:** In 1989, at Kauffman Stadium, George Brett singled off Roy Smith for his 2,500th career hit in a 6-0 win over the Twins...Twins radio ace Dan Gladden went 2-for-4 in the game with a single and a double.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Santana allowed four runs on eight hits in 6.2 innings with two strikeouts, but did factor into the decision in his last start on September 3 vs. Kansas City...surrendered a two-run homer to Melky Cabrera in the top of the sixth inning...left with a 3-2 lead as two runs were allowed by Alan Busenitz in the seventh on a Lorenzo Cain triple...has pitched 5.0-plus innings for eight straight outings.

**AGAINST THE ROYALS:** Santana is 6-10, 4.63 ERA (151.2 IP, 78 ER) in 24 career starts vs. Kansas City...allowed four runs on eight hits in 6.2 innings, but did not factor into the decision in his last start vs. the Royals on September 3...last earned the win vs. Kansas City on April 3 (Season Opener), allowing one run on two hits in 7.0 innings...is 3-4, 4.15 ERA (82.1 IP, 38 ER) with 81 strikeouts in 13 career starts vs. the Royals at Kauffman Stadium...last win at Kauffman was as a Royal on July 19, 2013 over Detroit, his last as an opponent came May 31, 2010 as an Angel.

**ROAD SWEET ROAD:** Is 8-2, 2.48 ERA (87.0 IP, 24 ER) in 13 road starts this season...his last loss came June 13 at Kansas City...AL road ranks: second in ERA, tied for third in wins and opponent average (.202), seventh in innings pitched, tied for 12th in strikeouts (72).

**ON THE LEADERBOARD:** Santana currently ranks first in all of baseball in shutouts (3) and complete games (5), tied for seventh in wins (14), ninth in opponents average (.222) and in hits per nine innings (7.44).

**ON A ROLL:** Santana is 20-11, 2.98 ERA (298.2 IP, 99 ER) with opponents hitting .219 in his last 46 starts dating back to June 19, 2016...since that date, he ranks fifth in all of baseball in ERA (2.98), eighth in opponent average (.219), and ninth in WHIP (1.11) among qualified pitchers in that span.

**TWINS ARE COMPLETE:** Santana has recorded five complete games this season...the highest mark in all of baseball...Santana marks the first pitcher on the Twins organization to have five complete games since Carl Pavano who had seven in 2010.
