**THE TWINS:** The Twins have gone 2-0 thus far on their seven-game homestand, beating the Angels the last two days...tonight they will play the three-game series finale with Anaheim, then welcome the Orioles for four from Thursday through Sunday...the Twins are 18-25 at home and 25-15 on the road.

**FIREWORKS SET-OFF AT TARGET FIELD:** The Twins beat the Angels yesterday afternoon by a score of 5-4, taking the series, making them 14-12-1 in series play in 2017...they improved to 10-4 in one-run games this season...Kyle Gibson (5-6) was the starter and winner, improving to 5-2 in his last nine starts...Taylor Rogers earned his AL-leading 19th hold and Brandon Kintzler earned his 22nd save (2nd in AL)...the offense recorded 11 hits, three coming from Byron Buxton, tying his career-high.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Twins announced today that they have placed left-handed pitcher Hector Santiago on the 10-day disabled list with upper thoracic back pain and discomfort... Santiago, who spent time on the disabled list earlier this season with a left shoulder strain, has gone 4-8, 5.63 ERA (70.1 IP, 44 ER), with 31 walks and 51 strikeouts in 15 games (14 starts)...to replace Santiago on the 25-man roster, the Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Alan Busenitz from Triple-A Rochester.

**GETTING COMFORTABLE:** The Twins have won four of their last five at Target Field...after taking two of three from Chicago-AL June 20-22, they have now won back-to-back home series for the first time this season...tonight they seek their second home sweep of the season, previously April 3-6 vs. Kansas City (series opener)...additionally, in their last 12 home games, they are hitting .293 (120-for-410) with 19 home runs, a .358 on-base percentage and 5.4 runs-per-game.

**TWINS AND ANGELS:** The Twins are playing the final game of 2017 against the Angels...they are 5-1 against Anaheim this season...the Twins have won 10 of their last 13 against the Angels overall...they have won six straight over the Angels at home, dating back to 2015... four teams have ever lost at least six straight at Target Field:

THEY BELIEVE IN ANGELS:

☞ Joe Mauer is hitting .341 (107-for-314) with 16 doubles, 11 home runs, 56 RBI, 44 runs scored, 40 walks and a .415 on-base percentage in 84 career games against the Angels...his .341 average is the second highest all-time against the Angels (minimum 200 at-bats), trailing Jose Altuve (.358).

☞ Max Kepler has hit safely in eight straight against the Angels...in 11 career games, he is hitting .371 (13-for-35) with two doubles, three home runs, eight RBI and a .436 on-base percentage.

☞ Miguel Sanó has hit safely in seven straight against the Angels, hitting .433 (13-for-30) in those games...in 15 career games vs. LAA, he is hitting .310 (18-for-58) with a .403 OBP.

☞ Robbie Grossman is hitting .318 (21-for-66) with a .384 on-base percentage in his last 19 games against the Angels.

**BRING A BROOM:** A win today would give the Twins their sixth sweep of an opponent this season (3 games vs. KC April 3-6, 2 games at KC April 28-30, 2 games at CWS May 9-11, 3 games at BAL May 22-24, and 3 games at CLE June 23-25)...the Twins last three-game sweep of the Angels came April 15-17, 2016 at Target Field.

**ROGER THAT:** Yesterday afternoon, Taylor Rogers allowed a home run to Albert Pujols, his first run allowed since June 1 at Los Angeles-AL (Kole Calhoun solo homer), snapping a streak of 11 straight scoreless appearances...Rogers has 19 holds, the most in the AL and tied with Colorado's Adam Ottavino for most in baseball...Ryan Pressly led the club in holds in 2016 with 14...Rogers is on pace for 37 holds which would set a club record and pass Matt Guerrier (2009) and J.C. Romero (2002) who share the record at 33.

**ABOVE AVERAGE JOE:** Joe Mauer has reached base in 15 of his last 16 games, hitting .328 (20-for-61) with nine walks and a .414 on-base percentage...during that span, he is hitting .341 (14-for-41) with a .449 on-base percentage against right-handed pitching.

**HAPPY HAPPY JORGE!:** Infielder Jorge Polanco is celebrating his 24th birthday today...he has never played a major league game on his birthday...he spent his birthday last season at Triple-A Rochester, going 0-for-3 with a walk vs. Buffalo...he shares a birthday with former Twin Jesse Crain (36).

**CALIFORNIA THROWBACKS:** Twins Manager Paul Molitor had a career .333 (258-for-775) average in 192 games against the Angels, including 45 doubles, seven triples, 19 home runs, 97 RBI, 128 runs scored and a .396 on-base percentage...his .333 batting average was the highest of his career vs. any opponent.
