**THE TWINS:** The Twins have gone 5-5 through 10 games on their 11-game roadtrip, going 3-0 at Progressive Field, 1-3 at Fenway Park and 1-2 at Kauffman Stadium...today they will play the four-game series finale at Kauffman Stadium...following today's game, the Twins will travel home to begin a seven-game homestand with three against the Angels (July 3-5) an four against the Orioles (July 6-9)...the Twins are 16-25 at home and 25-14 on the road.

**TWINS SPLIT THE DAY IN KANSAS CITY:** The Twins split the doubleheader yesterday in Kansas City, losing the first game by a score of 6-11 and winning the second game by a score of 10-5...Felix Jorge made his major league debut in the second game, allowing three runs on seven hits in 5.0 innings pitched...on the day, Twins hitters went 26-for-80 (.325) with 10 extra-base hits (8 doubles, two home runs) and 12 walks.

**TWINS AND ROYALS:** The Twins and Royals are playing the 12th of 19 games this season...they are 8-3 against the Royals this season...they have scored 28 of their 67 runs against the Royals in the seventh inning-or-later.

⚾ Miguel Sanó has hit safely in each of his last 13 games against the Royals, hitting .373 (19-for-51) with two doubles, one triple, five home runs, 24 RBI, 13 runs scored and a .448 on-base percentage.

**KING OF KAUFFMAN:** Joe Mauer has hit .324 (111-for-343) with 24 doubles, two triples, six home runs, 57 RBI, 45 runs scored and .416 on-base percentage in 92 career games at Kauffman...below are Mauer's ranks in five different categories among active opponents at the K:

**ADDITIONALLY...**Through 81 games last season, the Twins were 17-26 at home and 10-28 on the road...through 81 games last season (July 3), the Twins were in last place in the AL Central and 22.0 games behind the Indians.

**GRANITE WINS THE MONTH:** Triple-A Rochester outfielder Zack Granite has been named the International League Player of the Month for June, the league office announced Saturday...Granite led the league with a .470 batting average, 55 hits, 16 extra-base hits, 23 runs scored, 78 total bases, a .527 on-base percentage and a 1.193 OPS in June...the 24-year-old was rewarded with his first mid-season All-Star selection earlier this week...Granite reached base safely in all 29 games he played in June, tied for the longest on-base streak in the league this season...for the season, Granite paces the league with a .367 batting average and a .419 on-base percentage...his batting average is 50 points higher than any other qualified IL batter and ranks third among all minor leaguers...Granite is the first Rochester player honored as league Player of the Month since Colabello in June of 2013.

**TWINS MINOR LEAGUE POW:** Rookie-Level Elizabethton outfielder Trey Cabbage has been named Twins minor league Player of the Week...in seven games, Cabbage hit .333 (9-for-27) with two doubles, two home runs, nine RBI, eight walks and a .486 on-base percentage...previous winners of this award this season have been (in order): infielder Travis Blankenhorn, pitcher Lachlan Wells, infielder Jermaine Palacios, outfielder Lewin Diaz, outfielder LaMonte Wade, outfielder/infielder Chris Paul, right-handed pitcher John Curtiss, right-handed pitcher Sean Poppen, outfielder Zack Granite and right-handed pitcher Tyler Wells.

**WE GO WAY BACK:** On this day in...1987, Minnesota native, Jim Eisenreich, making a comeback into the major leagues, hits his first major league home run since 1982 to lead the Royals to a 10-3 win over his former club, the Twins...in 2012, the Twins beat the Tigers by a score of 6-4 at Comerica Park to give Ron Gardenhire his 900th career managerial victory...in 2015, Miguel Sanó made his major league debut at Kansas City, going 1-for-4, hitting an infield single off Greg Holland.
