**THE TWINS:** The Twins completed their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 3-4, going 1-2 at Tampa Bay and 2-2 at Kansas City...tonight the Twins will begin a six-game homestand with two against San Diego tonight and tomorrow, followed by four against Toronto from Thursday-Sunday...the Twins are 35-37 at home and 39-32 on the road...they are 15-10 in their last 25 and 22-13 in their last 35.

**TWINS CRUSHED OUT OF KC:** The Twins lost to the Royals on Sunday afternoon by a score of 11-3...Bartolo Colón (6-12) was the starter and loser, allowing six runs on six hits in 1.2 innings pitched...the offense recorded eight hits, two from Ehire Adrianza and two from Kennys Vargas, who hit his 10th home run of the season.

**30 FOR 30:** Brian Dozier enters today with 29 home runs...after hitting 42 last season, he is looking to become the fifth different Twin to hit 30 in consecutive seasons (since 1961):

**MEASURING MAUER'S METRICS - HIS CASE FOR THE GOLD:** Tracked by Inside Edge - tracks the number of balls hit to a player at each difficulty and the percentage of those plays they made this season...for example, if a player has been hit 40 "Likely" balls and has made 35 plays on those 40, they would have a "Likely" rate of 87.5%...below are Mauer's rankings among AL first basemen from 10-90%:

**IL PLAY:** The Twins have gone 11-7 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-2 vs. Colorado, 2-1 at San Francisco, 0-3 at Los Angeles-NL, 1-1 at San Diego, 4-0 vs. Milwaukee and 3-0 vs. Arizona...11 wins are their most since going 12-6 in 2009; club record is 16-2 in 2006...they are 201-179 all-time in Interleague Play, ninth most wins in MLB since IL began in 1997...they are 90-102 all-time in road IL games and 111-77 at home.

☞ They have won eight straight IL games, their longest streak since June 17-27, 2008, when they won 10 straight.

☞ Notables in IL games this season: Jorge Polanco is hitting .372 (16-for-43)...Byron Buxton is hitting .320 (16-for-50)...Eddie Rosario is hitting .316 (18-for-57) with 11 RBI...Joe Mauer is hitting .309 (17-for-55).

**TWINS-PADRES:** The Twins are 13-5 all-time against the Padres, posting a .722 winning percentage, the highest vs. any NL opponent...they last played a two-game series at Petco Park August 1-2, losing game one 3-0 and winning game two 5-2...they are hosting the Padres for the first time since August 5-6, 2014, splitting a two-game series...they are 4-1 all-time against the Padres at Target Field, 6-1 at Petco Park, 2-1 at Qualcomm Stadium, and 1-2 at Metrodome.

**ROSTER MOVE:** The Twins announced today that they have selected the contract of left-handed pitcher Gabriel Moya from Double-A Chattanooga...Moya, who was acquired in a trade with Arizona in exchange for catcher John Ryan Murphy on July 27, 2017, posted a combined record of 6-1, 0.77 ERA (58.1 IP, 5 ER), 15 walks, 87 strikeouts and a .150 opponent batting average in 47 relief appearances between Double-A Jackson and Chattanooga in 2017...the 22-year-old, Cabimas, VZ native has pitched in parts of six minor league seasons posting a career record of 22-10 with a 2.57 ERA (263.0 IP, 75 ER), 74 walks and 336 strikeouts...to make room on the 40-man roster for Moya, the Twins have designated infielder Engelb Vielma for release or assignment.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 1986, the Twins replaced Manager Ray Miller with Tom Kelly...the Twins won the first game managed by Kelly over the Texas Rangers 4-2 in the Metrodome...TK went on to becoming the winningest Manger in Twins history, going 1140-1244, winning two World Championships ('87 & '91) and had his number 10 retired by the Twins in 2012...additionally, in 1993, Paul Molitor drove in his 100th run of the year in the Blue Jays 4-1 win over California...he became the oldest player in major league history to record his first 100-RBI season.

**HAPPY BIRTHDAY J-R0W!** Twins Hitting Coach James Rowson is celebrating his 41st birthday today...he shares a birthday with Freddie Freeman, former basketball player Yao Ming, comedian Louis CK, drummer Neil Pert, rapper 2 Chainz, quarterback Andrew Luck, and Dan Gladden's favorite rapper Bizzy Bone.

**2018:** The Twins announced their preliminary regular season schedule for the 2018 season, the 58th campaign in Twins Territory...Minnesota will open the season on the road against Baltimore (March 29, 31 and April 1)...the Twins will open their ninth season at Target Field against the Mariners (April 5, 7-8)...the Twins will play 20 Interleague games...the home Interleague schedule includes home series against Cincinnati (April 27-29), St. Louis (May 15-16), a weekend series against Milwaukee (May 18-20) and a visit by Pittsburgh (August 14-15)...in addition, the Twins will make Interleague roadtrips to Pittsburgh (April 2, 4), St. Louis (May 7-8), Chicago (June 29-July 1) and Milwaukee (July 2-4)...2018 features 43 home games between Memorial Day (May 28) and Labor Day (September 3)...the Twins will play 16 home games in the month of April, 11 in May, 15 in June, 13 in July, 14 in August and 12 in September.

**WE'RE BRINGIN' SEXY BACK:** The Twins will be celebrating Big Sexy Night on Friday night vs. the Blue Jays as Bartolo "Big Sexy" Colón will make the start...fans can purchase tickets through this special ticket package to secure a seat and an exclusive T-shirt...Colón was given the nickname "Big Sexy" from former New York Mets teammate Noah Syndergaard from 2014-16.

**LAST TIME OUT FOR TWINS:** Gibson allowed two runs on eight hits in 7.0 innings with one walk but did not factor into the decision in his last start on September 7 at Kansas City... was his first outing this season without recording any strikeouts...has a record of 3-0, 1.69 ERA (26.2 IP, 5 ER) with just three walks and 20 strikeouts in his last four starts... is 4-2, 3.19 ERA (48.0 IP, 17 ER) with three home runs allowed in his last eight starts.

**AGAINST THE PADRES:** Is making his first career start and appearance vs. the San Diego Padres.

**INTERLEAGUE PLAY:** Tonight will mark Gibson's first Interleague start this season...is 3-8, 5.68 ERA (76.0 IP, 48 ER) with 20 walks and 55 strikeouts in 13 career starts vs. the NL... his last IL win came August 17, 2016 at Atlanta, pitching a complete game.

**THEY HAVE HIS BACK:** The Twins are giving Gibson 6.7 runs of support per start, the second highest mark in the American League among pitchers to make at least 24 starts... is the only pitcher in baseball this season to win multiple games in which he gave up six or more runs...Minnesota is 14-11 in Gibson's starts this season, including going 5-1 in his last six starts.

**TROUBLE WITH THE LONG BALL:** Gibson is allowing 1.26 home runs per 9.0 innings this season, up from his career average of 1.00...has allowed 19 homers in his 135.1 innings this season...seven of the 19 homers have come with runners on base...allowed a career-high 20 home runs in 147.1 innings last season...has allowed just three homers in his last eight starts (47.0 IP).

**NOT SO LUCKY:** Opponents are hitting .335 on balls in play vs. Gibson this season, and .363 on balls in play at Target Field...Gibson fell victim to a .332 opponents average on balls in play last season, the fifth-highest mark in the American League among pitchers to make at least 25 starts.

**DOUBLING THEM UP:** Has induced 18 groundball double plays in his last 18 starts (104.0 IP) after producing just four in his first seven starts (31.1 IP)...ranks second in the American League in double plays since May 28 (18)...his 18 double plays lead the Twins...ranked tied for fifth in the American League with 21 double plays last season.

**PITCHING IN PATTERNS:** Gibson began the season with an 0-4 record before winning four straight decisions from May 22-June 13...his four-game winning streak matched a career-long (June 27-July 12, 2015)...posted a 5.46 ERA (28.0 IP, 17 ER) during the winning streak...is 5-6, 4.11 ERA (81.0 IP, 37 ER) in 14 starts since the winning streak came to an end.

**MR. 100:** Gibson made his 100th career start on April 12 at Detroit, all with Minnesota...is the first pitcher to make 100 starts for the Twins since Francisco Liriano from 2005-11... is the 25th pitcher in Twins history to make 100-plus starts for the club.

**PUTTING THE "K" IN KYLE:** Gibson has tallied 100-plus strikeouts in three straight seasons, becoming the first Twins starter to do so since Scott Baker from 2008-10...his 480 strikeouts since 2013 lead the club...he's racked up the most strikeouts by a Twin in his first four seasons since Kyle Lohse from 2001-04; he ranks 11th in club history for strikeouts in a player's first four seasons.

## CAREER NOTES

- Given 2015 Joseph W. Haynes Award for Twins Pitcher of the Year voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of the BBWAA.
- His 2.85 ERA pre-ASG in 2015 was the fourth lowest for a Twins starter since 1992 with a minimum of 80.0 IP (Liriano - 1.83 in 2006, Santana - 2.75 in 2007, Radke - 2.77 in 1998).
- In 2014, his first full season in the majors, became one of three pitchers in Twins history to win each of their first three games while posting a sub-1.00 ERA.
- Earned the win in his MLB debut 6/29/13 vs. KC allowing three runs on eight hits in 6.0 innings.
- Named the Twins Minor League Player of the Week, ending May 12, 2013 after tossing his CG SHO.
- Was named an Arizona Fall League Rising star in 2012 and the AFL Player of the Week, 10/23/12.
- Selected to the 2011 Futures Game where he tossed 1.1 inning, allowing two hits.
- Named to the 2010 Eastern League Mid-Season All-Star Team.
- Named the Florida State League Pitcher of the Week, May 3, 2010.
- Selected in the first round (22nd overall) by the Twins in the 2009 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Missouri as a senior...major was communications.
