THE TWINS: The Twins finished the "first half" of the season with a record of 45-43 and completed their final homestand with a record of 4-3 (2-1 vs. LAA and 2-2 vs. BAL)...tonight they will play game one of a three-game roadtrip in Houston...following Sunday's finale, the Twins will travel home for a six-game, seven-day homestand with three against the Yankees Monday-Wednesday, an off-day Thursday, and three against the Tigers over the weekend...the Twins are 20-28 at home and 25-15 on the road.

SOUTH BEACH MEMORIES: The AL beat the NL on Tuesday night at Marlins Park by a score of 2-1 in 10 innings.

- On Sunday afternoon Nick Gordon represented the Twins in the SiriusXM Futures Game, leading off and playing shortstop for the US...he went 1-for-3 with a single and run scored.
- On Monday night Miguel Sanó participated in the T-Mobile Home Run Derby...Sanó was the fifth seed and faced Mike Moustakas in round one, winning 11 to 10...he then faced Gary Sánchez in the semifinals and won, 11 to 10...he then lost to Aaron Judge in the finals 11 to 10.
- On Tuesday night Sanó, Brandon Kintzler and Ervin Santana each appeared in the All-Star Game...Sanó entered the game in the bottom of the fourth at third base and drove in the AL's first run with a single...Kintzler pitched the bottom of the fifth, inducing three groundball outs...Santana pitched the bottom of the sixth inning, allowing a solo home run to Yadier Molina.

TWINS AND ASTROS: The Twins are playing the fourth of six games this season against the Astros tonight...they were swept in three games at Target Field from May 29-31...their last series at Minute Maid Park came May 2-4, 2016, winning game one and losing the second and third game...the Twins are 24-24 all-time against the Astros, including a record of 13-15 since the Astros joined the American League in 2013...they are looking to snap a six-game losing streak to the Astros and beat them for the first time since August 8, 2016.

- Robbie Grossman played for Houston from 2013-15...he hit .240 (160-for-666) with 30 doubles, 11 home runs and 63 RBI in 190 games.
- Jason Castro played his entire career with Houston prior to signing with the Twins this off-season...he was drafted by the Astros in the first round (10th overall) of the 2008 First-Year Player Draft...he played six seasons with the Astros, hitting .232 (469-for-2018) with 114 doubles, 62 home runs and 212 RBI in 617 games.
- Right-handed pitcher Tyler Duffey is a native of Houston and makes his off-season home there.

ROAD CONSTRUCTION: The Twins have gone 25-15 on the road this season, posting a .625 winning percentage, the second highest road winning percentage in baseball, trailing only Houston (.750)...they are four wins away from matching their 2016 road win total of 29-52.

ICYMI: Triple-A Rochester catcher Mitch Garver was named the International League Batter of the Week, the league office announced Monday...Garver hit .321 (9-for-28) with two doubles, five home runs, eight RBI and 10 runs scored in seven games during the week...he led the league in home runs, total bases (26), runs scored and slugging (.929) while tying for the league-lead in extra-base hits (7) during the week, which began July 3...Garver capped his week with his second career three homer day, going deep three times on Sunday vs. Syracuse to end the pre-All-Star break schedule...he became the first Red Wing to hit three home runs at home since Cal Ripken, Jr. at Silver Stadium on April 27, 1981 vs. Charleston...the other time Garver went yard three times was with Single-A Cedar Rapids on July 21, 2014 vs. Fort Wayne...Garver joins Jose Berríos (2x) and Nik Turley as Red Wings to earn a weekly league honor in 2017.

GOING ONLINE: Facebook and MLB have partnered to stream a weekly national game telecast; announced by Commissioner Manfred on May 18 at the conclusion of the MLB owners meetings...these weekly regular season broadcasts air on Friday nights in 2017 and are accessible live to everyone on Facebook in the US...this week's game will be tonight's Twins at Astros...the games will be available on the official MLB Facebook page.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2015, at Great American Ballpark, Brian Dozier and Glen Perkins represented the Twins in the All-Star Game...Dozier homered off Mark Melancon in the eighth inning and Glen Perkins finished the game, allowing a run in the ninth.

THIS AND THAT:

- Miguel Sanó is hitting .311 (14-for-45) with nine RBI in his last 11 games.
- Max Kepler is hitting .305 (68-for-223) with 19 doubles and 10 home runs against right-handed pitching this season.
- Byron Buxton has hit safely in five straight games, hitting .474 (9-for-19) with a .500 on-base percentage in that span.
- Eduardo Escobar needs two doubles to reach 100 for his career.

LAST TIME OUT: Berríos earned his eighth win of the season in his last start on July 6 vs. Baltimore, allowing four runs (3 earned) on seven hits in 6.0 innings...surrendered a two-run homer to Mark Trumbo in the second inning...did not walk a batter for the second time in his career (also: August 1, 2016 in 6.0 innings at Cleveland).

AGAINST THE ASTROS: Berríos is 1-2, 8.03 ERA (12.1 IP, 11 ER) in three career starts vs. Houston...suffered the loss in his last start on May 30 at Target Field, allowing four runs in 5.0 innings with a season-high four walks and five strikeouts...earned his first-career win in his only career start at Minute Maid Park on May 2, 2016, allowing two runs in 5.1 innings with eight strikeouts...was his second-career start.

BETTER WITH AGE: Berríos already has more wins (8) in 11 starts this season than he did in 14 starts last season (3)...at 69 strikeouts on the year, he's already surpassed his season total from last season (49)...has thrown 71.1 innings this season in 11 starts after throwing 58.1 innings in 14 starts last season...overall, was 3-7 with a 8.02 ERA (58.1 IP, 52 ER) in his 14 starts last season and is 8-2, 3.53 ERA (71.1 IP, 28 ER) in 11 starts this season.

SINCE HIS PROMOTION: Since his first start of the season on May 7, Berríos ranks second in the American League in WHIP (1.08), tied for second in wins (8), third in opponent average (.221) and ninth in ERA (3.53).

BUILDING MOMENTUM: Berríos is 9-4, 3.80 ERA (87.2 IP, 37 ER) with 77 strikeouts in his last 15 starts dating back to last season...has allowed two runs or fewer in eight of the 15 starts...Minnesota has won nine of his last 15 starts.

COOL UNDER PRESSURE: Opponents are hitting .200 (19-for-95) with 33 strikeouts with runners on base this season vs. Berríos, and .224 (11-for-49) with 18 strikeouts with a runner in scoring position.

STICKING AROUND: Berríos has thrown 6.0-plus innings in eight of his 11 starts this season...pitched into the seventh inning in three of his last five starts...pitched 6.0-plus innings just once in his 14 starts last season, and 5.0-plus innings just seven times.

NOT BAD, KID: Berríos recorded a career-high 11 strikeouts on May 18 vs. Colorado, becoming the youngest pitcher to record 11-plus strikeouts in a game this season, and the youngest Twin to do so since Francisco Liriano on July 28, 2006 vs. Detroit...is the first Twin to record 11-plus strikeouts in a game since Ervin Santana on September 5, 2015 at Houston...is the first Twin to collect 11-plus strikeouts and not allow a run since Liriano on August 1, 2010 vs. Seattle.

UNDER CONTROL: Berríos is averaging 2.40 walks per nine innings this season, walking three-plus batters just twice in his 11 starts...averaged 5.40 walks per nine innings last season, issuing three or more walks in seven of his 14 starts.

A PITCHER'S BEST FRIEND: Berríos has induced eight groundball double plays this season, tied with Kyle Gibson for the most on the Twins since his promotion on May 7...ranks tied for first in all of baseball with eight double plays since May 28 (also: Sam Gaviglio, Kyle Gibson and Drew Pomeranz)...induced just five groundball double plays in 14 starts last season.

FOR THE RED WINGS: Was 3-0, 1.13 ERA (39.2 IP, 5 ER) with eight walks and 39 strikeouts in six starts for Triple-A Rochester this season...ranked first in the International League in ERA and WHIP (0.81), tied for second in wins, third in innings pitched and fourth in strikeouts...promoted to Minnesota on May 12.

WORLD BASEBALL CLASSIC: Berríos played for Team Puerto Rico in the 2017 World Baseball Classic, going 1-0, 8.10 ERA (6.2 IP, 6 ER) with two walks and 10 strikeouts.
