LAST TIME OUT: Gee suffered his first loss of the season in his last start on August 26 at Toronto, allowing four runs on seven hits in 4.0 innings with five strikeouts...Gee allowed two home runs, one to Kendrys Morales in the second inning and another to Josh Donaldson in the fifth...was his second start as a Twin and third start of the season.

HOW DID I GET HERE?: Began 2017 with Triple-A Round Rock (Texas)...recalled by Texas in late May...designated for assignment in mid-June and elected free agency...signed with Twins as minor league free agent on June 22 and reported to Triple-A Rochester...recalled by Minnesota August 1.

AGAINST THE ROYALS: Gee is making his second career start vs. the Royals...his first and only career start against Kansas City came on August 2, 2013 in which he threw 7.0 innings allowing one run on three hits with four strikeouts, as a member of the New York Mets...will be his first start as a Twin at Target Field.

- Gee spent the 2016 season with the Kansas City Royals, going 8-9, 4.68 ERA (125.0 IP, 65 ER) with 37 walks and 89 strikeouts...Gee made 33 appearances and had 14 starts with the Royals.

HOME SWEET HOME: Gee is 24-24 in 86 career appearances (67 starts) at his home field as a member of New York - NL, Kansas City and the Twins...has a 3.59 ERA (458.2 IP, 183 ER) with 155 walks and 332 strikeouts.

IN THE MINORS: Gee opened the 2017 season with Triple-A Round Rock, going 3-4, 3.88 ERA (51.0 IP, 22 ER) with 13 walks and 43 strikeouts in nine starts...led Round Rock in innings pitched (51.0) and strikeouts (43)...prior to his contract being selected in June, Gee pitched five games with Triple-A Rochester...went 3-1 with a 2.00 ERA (27.0 IP, 6 ER), three walks and 20 strikeouts.

A BUMP IN THE ROAD: Gee was diagnosed with thoracic outlet syndrome after blood clots were discovered in his right shoulder and lungs following his last outing on September 25, 2016 at Detroit...had surgery on October 11...was ready for the start of 2017 spring training.

2016 RECAP:

- Was 4-8, 5.55 ERA (73.0 IP, 45 ER) in 14 starts with the Kansas City Royals.
- Joined Baltimore's Dylan Bundy as the only major league pitchers to record at least 14 starts and 19 relief outings.
- Had made just three relief appearances prior to 2016.
- Ranked fifth on the Royals in wins (5), starts, and innings (125.0).
- Opponents had a .291 batting average vs. Gee.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - KYLE GIBSON, RHP (SEASON- 8-10, 5.59 ERA // CAREER- 40-48, 4.77 ERA)

Gibson allowed two runs on seven hits in 6.2 innings with one walk and seven strikeouts, earning his eighth win of the season in his last start on August 27 at Toronto...Gibson was recalled on August 4 after being optioned on July 25, making his second stint with the Red Wings this season...is 0-0, 5.23 ERA (10.1 IP, 6 ER) in two starts vs. Kansas City this season...is 5-4, 3.79 ERA (80.2 IP, 34 ER) in 13 career starts vs. the Royals.

- Has now pitched for four different organizations since 2010: New York-NL from 2010-15, Kansas City in 2016, Texas in 2017 and Minnesota in 2017.
 - Was the Mets' opening day starter in 2014..went 7-8, 4.00 ERA (137.1 IP, 61 ER) in 22 starts.
 - In 2012, Gee found to have a clot in an artery in his right shoulder in and underwent surgery on 7/13...missed the remainder of the season.
 - Led all Triple-A pitchers with 165 strikeouts with Buffalo...was recalled on 9/6 and won at WAS in MLB debut the following day in 2010.
 - Made nine starts in 2009 to open the year at Buffalo before being sidelined for the season on 5/29 with a partially torn labrum in his right shoulder.
 - Selected by New York-NL in the 21st round of the 2007 First-Year Player Draft.

- Twins bullpen has a 4.51 ERA (456.2 IP, 229 ER) this season, which ranks 13th among AL teams...the pen has allowed a .263 opponent average with 150 walks and 388 strikeouts.
- Since August 2 the bullpen has the 5th best ERA in the AL with a 3.30 ERA (92.2 IP, 34 ER)...in that same span their 0.95 WHIP (65 H, 23 BB) is best in the majors.
- Six different Twins have converted saves this season, including Kintzler (28), Belisle (3), Duffey (1), Gee (1), Haley (1) and Hildenberger (1).
