THE TWINS: After completing their six-game homestand with a record of 4-2 (3-0 vs. Chicago-AL and 1-2 vs. Kansas City), the Twins lost consecutive games to the Rays the last two nights...today they will play the three-game series finale at Tropicana Field before traveling to Kansas City for four from Thursday-Sunday...the Twins are 35-37 at home and 36-30 on the road...they are 19-11 in their last 30, but 1-4 in their last five.

ANOTHER L, WHEN TWINS NEED A W: The Twins lost to the Rays last night by a score of 2-1, suffering their 20th series loss this season (21-20-4)...Bartolo Colón (6-11) was the starter and loser, allowing two runs on five hits in 6.2 innings pitched...the offense recorded just four hits, including a solo home run from Robbie Grossman in the ninth inning...they placed just two runners in scoring position (0-for-2)...the game was played in 2 hours and 32 minutes.

MAUER MILESTONES: Joe Mauer needs one RBI to pass Justin Morneau and move into fifth on the Twins all-time RBI list and six runs scored to tie Rod Carew for third:

TWINS AND RAYS: The Twins are 1-4 against the Rays this season...they are looking to avoid losing five games to the Rays in one season for the first time since going 1-6 in 2013.

☞ Eddie Rosario has hit safely in 12 of 14 career games against the Rays, hitting .370 (17-for-46) with four doubles, three home runs and five RBI.

☞ Joe Mauer has reached safely via hit or walk in 25 straight against the Rays...he is a career .361 (90-for-249) hitter against Tampa Bay with 17 doubles, two triples, four home runs, 46 walks, 36 runs scored and just 40 strikeouts in 67 games...his .361 average and .460 on-base percentage both rank as the highest against the Rays all-time.

☞ Mauer has hit .386 (51-for-132) in 34 career games at Tropicana Field with a .491 on-base percentage, both the highest ever in this ballpark...he has reached base safely in 33 of 34 career games at Tropicana Field.

ABOVE AVERAGE JOE: Joe Mauer has hit safely in a season-high 14 straight games, hitting .418 (23-for-55) with eight doubles in that span, the longest streak in the AL and second longest in baseball, trailing Philadelphia's Odubel Herrera's 19-game streak...Mauer's last streak of more than 14 came June 19-August 15, 2014, when he tied his career-long with 16 straight...he has five career streaks as long as his current streak (16, 16, 15, 15 and 14)...in fact, in 25 games since August 10, he is hitting .420 (42-for-100) which leads baseball.

STEADY EDDIE: Eddie Rosario is hitting .311 (83-for-267) with 21 doubles, 15 home runs, 45 RBI, 42 runs scored, 21 walks and a .355 on-base percentage in his last 73 games, dating back to June 13...he ranks fourth in baseball in games in left field (119), trailing Marcell Ozuna (132), Adam Duvall (131) and Justin Upton (129)...his 119 games in left are the most for a Twin since Josh Willingham played 119 in 2012; next Twin to play more was Delmon Young with 149 in 2010.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2002, Brad Radke pitched the Twins to a 6-0 victory at the Metrodome, beating the A's, snapping Oakland's 20-game win streak...Radke pitched a complete game shutout with six hits allowed and one walk...in 2016, The Twins lost 10-3 to the Royals, but Brian Dozier homered in his fifth straight game, tying a team record, and gave him 39, tying the American League record for a second baseman set by Alfonso Soriano (2003).

ROBERTO CLEMENTE DAY: Major League Baseball yesterday announced that Joe Mauer was named the Twins 2017 nominee for the prestigious Roberto Clemente Award, the most prominent individual player award bestowed by MLB...the Roberto Clemente Award is the annual recognition of a player from each MLB club who best represents the game of Baseball through extraordinary character, community involvement, philanthropy and positive contributions, both on and off the field...today marks the 16th annual Roberto Clemente Day...Mauer is one of the 30 Club nominees for the annual award...the Twins will recognize Mauer at an on-field ceremony later this season...Mauer's commitment to the community can be seen through his work with the Highland Friendship Club, Gillette Children's Specialty Healthcare and the Mauer's Minnie's ticket program.

- ☞ High-A Ft. Myers is playing a doubleheader today vs. Palm Beach (Game 2 moved from Thurs...). Miracle lost to PB last night 3-2...if Miracle win both, they will share FSL championship with the winner of Dunedin and Tampa (Hurricane Irma cancelled the potential championship).
- ☞ Low-A Cedar Rapids begins the Midwest League Division series tonight vs. Kane County in a best of three...right-handed pitcher Tyler Wells (5-3, 3.11 ERA) will make the start for the Kernels.
- ☞ Rookie-Elizabethon plays the decisive Game 3 tonight vs. Greenville...they lost Game 1 on Sunday 2-3 and won Monday 14-7...the winner advances to play Pulaski (NYY) in the Appy League finals.
