THE TWINS: The Twins began the "first half" of the season with a three-game series loss in Houston over the weekend, winning the middle game...tonight the Twins will begin a six-game, seven-day homestand with three against the Yankees tonight through Wednesday, an off-day Thursday, and three against the Tigers over the weekend...the Twins are 20-28 at home and 26-17 on the road.

TWINS CAN'T COMPLETE SERIES WIN IN HOUSTON: The Twins lost to the Astros yesterday afternoon by a score of 5-3, suffering their 13th series loss (14-13-2) this season...Kyle Gibson (5-8) was the starter and loser, allowing four runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched...the offense struck out 12 times and recorded five hits, two coming from Ehre Adrianza, who hit his first home run of the season and fourth of his career.

TWINS AND YANKEES: The Twins are playing the first of six games against the Yankees this season...they will travel to New York for a three-game series September 18-20...last season, the Twins went 2-5 against New York, going 1-3 at Target Field June 16-19 and 1-2 at Yankee Stadium June 24-26...the Twins have gone 2-2 in their last four but 2-10 in their last 12 against the Yankees.

- ❖ Brian Dozier has hit safely in each of his last six games against the Yankees, hitting .417 (10-for-24) with one double, one triple and three home runs in those games.
- ❖ Max Kepler is hitting .304 (7-for-23) with three doubles, two home runs, four RBI and a .385 on-base percentage in seven career games against the Yankees.
- ❖ Eddie Rosario is hitting .412 (7-for-17) with three doubles in four career games against the Yankees.
- ❖ Miguel Sanó is hitting .304 (7-for-23) with three home runs in six career games against the Yankees.
- ❖ Eduardo Escobar is hitting .304 (7-for-23) in his last six games vs. New York.
- ❖ Phil Hughes was drafted by the Yankees in the first round (23rd overall) of the 2004 First-Year Player Draft and pitched for them from 2007-13.
- ❖ Pitching coach Neil Allen pitched for the Yankees in 1985, 1987-88...he was also the Yankees bullpen coach in 2005.
- ❖ Hitting coach James Rowson was a minor league hitting coordinator and hitting coach in the Yankees system from 2006-11 and 14-16.

GERMAN JULI: Max Kepler is hitting .390 (16-for-41) with five doubles, one triple, one home run, eight RBI, seven walks and a .480 on-base percentage in 12 July games...among all players in baseball this month, he ranks third in on-base percentage and fourth in batting average.

HOME REMODEL: The Twins have gone 6-4 at Target Field since June 20 after starting the season going 14-24 at home...in their last 17 home games, they are hitting .281 (163-for-581) with 25 doubles, 20 home runs, a .346 on-base percentage and 5.1 runs-per-game...in that same span, they are hitting .347 (50-for-144) with runners in scoring position at home.

ESCO ON TARGET: Eduardo Escobar is hitting .386 (22-for-57) with five doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, 10 runs scored and a .435 on-base percentage in his last 15 games at Target Field...additionally, he enters tonight with 98 career doubles.

ROSIE FEELING MINNESOTA: Eddie Rosario is hitting .320 (49-for-153) with eight doubles, nine home runs, 13 walks, 21 runs scored and .371 on-base percentage in 45 games at Target Field.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1990, the Twins became the first team in baseball history to turn two triple plays in the same game...both were started on grounders to third baseman Gary Gaetti...the Twins lost to the Red Sox at Fenway Park, 1-0...Tom Brunansky hit into the first triple play.

1987 REUNION: The Twins will be celebrating the 30th Anniversary of the 1987 World Champion Twins from Thursday through Saturday...on Thursday at 6 pm, many players from the '87 roster will be on the field as fans can enjoy a program that includes interactive games, entertainment, photo opportunities, a VIP social reception, silent auction, dinner, and on-field program...Friday's events will include a Tom Kelly statue unveiling, pregame photo sessions and postgame fireworks...Saturday's events will include a commemorative beer stein giveaway, pregame photo sessions, media availability, '87 players introductions, pregame on-field ceremony, and more.

RIP, BOB WOLFF: Former Twins broadcaster Bob Wolff passed away yesterday at the age of 96...Wolff was on the original Twins broadcast team, along with Halsey Hall, Ray Scott and Herb Carneal.

LAST TIME OUT: Mejía suffered the loss in his last start on July 8 vs. Baltimore, allowing four runs in 6.2 innings...allowed a two-run homer to Jonathan Schoop in the fourth inning and two more runs in the sixth...snapped a three-game winning streak...matched a season-high with six strikeouts (3x).

AGAINST THE YANKEES: Mejía is making his first career appearance vs. New York.

ON A ROLL AS OF LATE: Mejía is 3-2 with a 2.79 ERA (29.0 IP, 9 ER) in his last five starts, holding opponents to a .223 average...has pitched into the seventh inning in two straight starts.

COOL UNDER PRESSURE: Mejía is holding opponents to a .176 average (21-for-119) with 33 strikeouts with runners on base and a .172 average (10-for-58) with 16 strikeouts with runners in scoring position...opponents are hitting .328 (43-for-131) vs. Mejía with nobody on base.

ON THE ROOKIE LEADERBOARD: Mejía ranks third among American League rookies in innings pitched (65.0) and tied for fourth in wins (4).

HOT AND COLD: Has pitched 5.0-plus innings and allowed two or fewer runs in five of his 13 starts this season, posting a 1.87 ERA (33.2 IP, 7 ER) in those games...hasn't done so in his other eight starts, posting a 6.57 ERA (38.1 IP, 28 ER)...has lasted fewer than 5.0 innings and allowed multiple runs in four of the latter starts.

WELL TRAVELED: Mejía began the season with Minnesota and made three starts, posting an 0-1 record with a 5.79 ERA (9.1 IP, 6 ER)...the Twins lost all three starts...was optioned to Triple-A Rochester on April 23...recalled to be the 26th man on the roster for a doubleheader with Kansas City on May 21 and started the second game, earning his first-career win after allowing three runs in 7.0 innings...returned to Rochester following the game but was recalled again on May 26 and started for Minnesota vs. Tampa Bay the following day...is making his 10th straight start with Minnesota on his current stint with the club...has posted a 3-3 record with a 4.25 ERA (48.2 IP, 23 ER) in that span.

FOR THE RED WINGS: Mejía was 0-1, 3.48 ERA (20.2 IP, 8 ER) with three walks and 16 strikeouts in four starts for Triple-A Rochester after being sent down on April 23.

STILL NEW TO TOWN: Acquired from San Francisco in exchange for 2016 All-Star Eduardo Nuñez on July 28, and reported to Triple-A Rochester...made three starts for the Red Wings, going 1-2, 4.66 ERA (19.1 IP, 10 ER) with three walks and 20 strikeouts before being recalled August 20...made major league debut August 20 at Kansas City, allowing two runs on five hits in 2.1 innings of relief...optioned back to Rochester following the game.

THE FUTURE IS NOW: Mejía participated in the 2016 MLB Futures Game at Petco Park for the World Team, pitching a scoreless ninth inning with a strikeout...Yankees catcher Gary Sanchez also played in the game...ranked by *Baseball America* as Minnesota's No. 6 prospect entering the 2017 season.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - BARTOLO COLÓN, RHP [SEASON- 2-8, 8.14 ERA // CAREER- 235-170, 4.02 ERA]

Colón signed as a minor league free agent with Minnesota on July 7 after being released by Atlanta on July 4...was 2-8, 8.14 ERA (63.0 IP, 57 ER) in 13 starts for the Braves...made one start for Triple-A Rochester on July 13 and suffered the loss, allowing four runs in 3.2 innings with two walks and five strikeouts...at 44 years old, Colón will be the oldest player to ever start a game for Minnesota.
