

WHITE SOX NOTES:

- The White Sox have lost three of their last four games overall and have lost four straight games to the Twins.
- Freddy Garcia is 1-4, 5.28 (58.0 ip, 34 er) allowing 73 hits in his last nine starts.
- Garcia allowed 10-or-more hits in a start for the fifth time this season and the second time in four August starts.
- Jermaine Dye tied his career-high with 33 homers, last done in 2000...he is batting .353 (12-34) with four homers and 13 RBI vs. the Twins this season.
- Brian Anderson committed his first career error in his 111th career game...he had 264 total chances with no error before the play.
- Paul Konerko extended his hit streak to seven straight games batting .464 (13-28) in that span.
- The Twins are 12-for-12 in stolen base attempts vs. Pierzynski this season.

TWINS NOTES:

- The Twins have gone 46-17 in their last 63 games, in that time they have the Majors best record and have outscored their opponent 350-234 in that time...they have won four of their last five games.
- Boof Bonser has given up 12 home runs in 50.2 innings pitched this season.
- The home run by Dye in the fourth inning as the first home run given up by Twins pitching in 150 plate appearances.
- Pat Neshek has inherited 12 runners this season and stranded them all...first batters faced are batting just .067 (1-15) off him.
- Jason Tyner stole a base for the first time since 9/23/05 at Chi.
- Jason Tyner is batting .500 (8-16) with three runs scored vs. the Sox this season.
- Torii Hunter hit his first home run in the month of August, a span of 69 plate appearances.
- Dennys Reyes has not given up a run since his appearance 7/5 at K.C, a span of 13.0 innings...he has stranded 24 of 29 inherited runners this season.
- The Twins bullpen has allowed just two runs in their last 31.0 innings pitched...coming into the game they had the Majors lowest ERA (3.04) this season.
